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## Election Forms

Please complete the following forms to be eligible for nomination in the Dalhousie Student Union Elections – 2019.

If you are considering running in the election, we advise that all candidates/campaigns review [DSU Bylaw 9](#), the [Elections Policy](#), [Referenda Policy](#), [Campaign Information and Rules](#), the [Elections Timeline](#), and the [Position Descriptions](#).

To be considered for nomination, candidates must complete the following:

1. This **Nomination Form**, including:

- Candidate name, program, and year;
- Desired position in the DSU;
- The first and last name, B00 number, and signature of 25 current Dal students;
- Candidate signature and date

\*This is to be submitted to the CRO (dsucro@dal.ca) before the end of the Nomination Period (February 16, 2019). Please submit both a scanned copy and excel version (excluding signatures) of this form to the CRO. If student signatures cannot be verified, it is the discretion of the CRO to allow candidates to replace nominators post-Nomination Period.

2. The **Candidate Questionnaire**, completed electronically and submitted to the CRO.

\*This is to be submitted no later than 12:00pm on the day prior to the commencement of the Campaign Period (February 28, 2019).

3. **Campaign Information Form**, including:

- List of Campaign Workers;
- Candidate Websites and Social Media Platforms for Campaign
